Our Instructor of Swordsmanship studied foil, epee, saber, rapier, and rapier & main gauche in Europe. In Hawaii, he practiced with the Japanese Samurai Swordsmen using both the "Shinai" (bamboo practice sword) and the "Katana" (live blade.) He is a very skillful instructor as well as swordsman. He is tactful and demanding and has already earned the respect and admiration of the Bushidokan Karate and Judo instructors. They say he is a true "Bushi" (warrior).

This course is designed to familiarize the student with the European system of swordsmanship, including use of the saber, epee & rapier. Instruction will, however, be concentrated on the use of the foil, the French foil for the ladies and the Italian foil for the gentlemen. Lectures and demonstration on the other weapons will be included throughout the course, with Instruction available for the more advanced swordsmen.
